

Best Practice 1

Goal: The goal of this practice is to give students a conceptual understanding of computers, computing and issues with technology.

The context: Computer literacy has received a significant amount of attention in recent years. The course develops students' computer literacy, keyboarding skills and meets his needs in the degree programme.

The practice: Computer classes have been introduced for all the major students of the college by incorporating it into the college routine. There is a computer lab with a 22 computers where the students can practice and sharpen their skills.

Evidence of success: The introduction of computer literacy course had a positive impact upon the students.

Best Practice 2

Goal: The aim of this practice is to improve the confidence and comfort level of the students in their interactions with their teachers and thereby bring out the best in them.

The context: In keeping with the NAAC Peer Team suggestion of the IQAC orienting itself to the core values of NAAC and of strengthening the mentoring system the members of the college IQAC decided to implement the concept of mentoring for all major students of the college.

The Practice: Students of each major class have been assigned to a teacher mentor who plays an advisory role, she/ he takes care of all the academic needs of the student and provides assistance with books and other study materials besides providing career counselling.

Evidence of success:

Students have benefitted immensely from being mentored, they have gained in self-confidence and teachers have also become more approachable. Provided with alternate career options students are also happier.
