In connection with "National Wildlife Week-2020", the Dept. of Chemistry, Sipajhar College has organized a state level "E-Poster Competition" in collaboration with "Environment and Climate cell, Sipajhar College" and "Sipajhar College Eco-Club". The programme was supported by "Assam Science Technology and Environment Council, Dept. of Science and Technology, Govt. of Assam" and Catalyzed by "Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India.

The aim of the programme was to explore and encourage creativity in students and offer them a platform to show their skills. In response to that we asked the students to submit the poster in two categories. But we did not receive the posters as expected, even some of the posters are found to be extremely poor in quality. Therefore, we decided to organize an orientation programme on behalf of "how to prepare a poster, important skills and issues to present it". This orientation programme was held on 22-10-2020, conducted through Google Meet. We invited Dr Bibhuti Ranjan Bhattacharya from IIT Guwahati and Dr. Nayan Mani Das from Sipajhar College as the resource persons to deliver their speech. The artistic endeavor of the students was highly praised by the resource persons throughout the programme.

Finally, the presentation of the poster making competition was done on 09-11-2020. We appoint judges from various institutions to observe the posters submitted by the students and their presentation skills. Two students with best posters from each category were awarded with bunches of books.
